Today we celebrated World Mental Health Day by wearing something yellow. It is important for us all to know that keeping mentally healthy is just as important as being physically healthy. Yellow, as a colour, often represents sunshine and happiness. Today we reminded the children that staying healthy, fit and well includes looking after our own mental health. We have asked the children how they look after themselves at school, e.g. sharing top tips for: what to do if they get stuck with their learning, cheering themselves up, looking after a friend, how they have helped another pupil or, how they have been helped by someone. We have also spoken to the children about it being 'okay to not feel okay' as long as they talk to someone about this so that we can help them. SEND Coffee Morning


On **Monday 11th October** we will be holding our second SEND (Special Educational Needs & Disabilities) parent coffee morning. The feedback from parents about the first coffee
